This outline may be adjusted during the course with consultation between students and tutor.

**Prerequisites:** This course builds on the skills and knowledge developed during the Handweavers and Spinners Guild Certificate of Four Shaft Weaving or Four Shaft Bridging Course, therefore these courses or equivalent experience in multishaft weaving are essential prerequisites. If in doubt, please discuss with the Guild.

All students will have use of a table loom for the duration of the course but must supply their own warping board to use at home.

**Course Content:** The following structures explored on 4 shafts will be expanded onto 8 shafts; Twill, Double Weave, Summer and Winter and Lace weaves. New structures include Brocade, Damask, Damask Pick up, Deflected Double Weave and Pique. Finally, students will look at yarn, fibre and finishes, quantity calculations and costing in preparation for the design and production of an article using at least one of the structures in the course.

Exercises will be set for each topic with samples and notes presented in a folio to be assessed at the end of the course.

Note: This course does not carry accreditation, however participants are asked to undertake genuine commitment to completion of all topics and submission of a folio and final project.
